## Safe Over-the-Counter Medication List during pregnancy

Allegra, Benadryl, Claritin, Mucinex, Zyrtec

Cold/Sinus: Tylenol (Acetaminophen) Cold & Sinus, Benadryl, Claritin, Mucinex, Singulair, Sudafed, Zyrtec

\*\*No products containing alcohol\*\*

Congestion: Tylenol (Acetaminophen) Cold & Sinus, Claritin, Sudafed, Tavist D, Vicks Vapor Rub

Cough: Robitussin DM, Vicks cough syrup, Vicks Vapor Rub

**Sore Throat:** Chloraseptic throat spray or lozenges, gargle with warm salt water as needed

Constipation: Colace, Dulcolax, Metamucil, Miralax, Senokot, Surfak, Milk of Magnesia (if no BM in 3 days)

**Diarrhea:** Immodium, Kaopectate, Pepto Bismol \*\*Call if persistent\*\*

Gas X, Maalox, Mylanta, Mylicon

Heartburn: Tums, Maalox, Mylanta, Pepcid AC, Prevacid, Prilosec, Zantac

Nausea/ Vomiting: Dramamine, Emetrol (if not diabetic only), Sea Bands, Vitamin B6 25mg three times a day

Hemorrhoids: Anusol, Preparation H, Sitz baths, Tucks pads, Witch Hazel

Headache/ Pain: Tylenol/Acetaminophen (regular or extra strength)

**Insomnia:** Tylenol (Acetaminophen) PM, Benadryl \*\*Avoid caffeine\*\*

**Yeast infection:** Monistat 7 night vaginal cream treatment

## \*\*As always, please call if any questions/concerns, or if above treatments do not work for your problem!\*\*

**Preterm Labor Precautions (36 weeks or less):** 5-6 contractions/cramps in an hour, vaginal bleeding, leaking fluid, and/or constant lower back pain

**Labor Precautions (37 weeks +):** Contractions every 5 minutes or less x one hour, leaking fluid, and/or vaginal bleeding more than spotting

\*\*Losing your mucus plug is NOT a sign of labor and you do not have to call to report\*\*

Note: Vaginal spotting is normal after a vaginal exam in the office or after having sexual intercourse
